

Treasure Basket (& Heuristic Play) resource ideas

The basket should be:

- round with a broad base and big opening at the top so that the baby can see and reach in and hold the basket close
- stable enough so a baby can rest his/her arm on the side without toppling
- made from natural material such as willow, wicker, straw, raffia
- no less than 14" (351mm) in diameter and 4-5" (101-125mm) deep

The contents:

- must be made from natural materials only
- should be between 50-100 of the same or similar items in each basket
- should be several of each different type of object so that there is sufficient of each resource to go around

Suggested Resources

Natural materials:

- feathers
- natural loofah
- orange
- lemon
- shells of differing sizes
- pebbles of differing sizes
- pinecone
- various fabrics satin, lace, chamois leather
- silk ribbon
- satin scarves
- natural sponge
- pumice stone

Made from wood:

- wooden kitchen roll holder
- wooden mug tree
- wooden massagers
- wooden spatula
- wooden spoons
- wooden pastry brush
- wooden egg cup
- wooden and metal curtain rings
- wooden bottle brush
- wooden shaving brush

Made from metal:

- jar lids
- measuring spoons
- tongues
- tea strainer
- whisk
- spoons
- chain various lengths and thickness
- saucepan lids
- metal teabag squeezer
- metal bowls, cups, plates

Other resource:

- cane coaster
- leather purse
- Cotton and silk velvet hair bands and scrunchies
- little natural baskets
- large wooden beads on a string
- wooden bangles
- wicker balls
